





Are You Prepared for OSHA's Crane Safety Training **Certification Requirement?**

While ISA continues to work toward a legislative fix or regulatory exemption, OSHA's requirement that all crane operators be certified is still scheduled to take effect on November 10, 2018. If you haven't already taken action, Please don't put this off any longer.

The mandate requires that the operator of any crane with a manufacturer-rated capacity over 2,000 pounds be certified. In May 2018, OSHA clarified the specific ongoing responsibilities for employers to ensure employees are "qualified" to operate each piece of equipment, beyond

the third-party certification requirement. Sign companies that fail to comply may have to shut down cranes and service trucks in November-or face stiff penalties from OSHA.

This requires a significant investment on the part of companies; the rules require that companies pay for the cost of certification-not the crane operators themselves. Companies also incur the cost of time since workers will be off work for a few days to pursue training and certification.

ISA has compiled a wealth of information to help sign companies prepare for the deadline at Signs.org/crane. In addition, a webinar focusing on last-minute tips for compliance before the deadline is planned for September and will be posted online at Signs.org/crane.
